### 2010 THE ORCHARDS PINOT GRIS

The encore to what Wine & Spirits proclaimed as one of the “**Year’s Best Pinot Gris**” simply sparkles on your tongue; greeting with peach aromas and dazzling with highlights of pear and crisp green apple. 2009 Orchards is sold out and 2010 is in short supply, so don’t delay if you want to stock your cellar with this beauty. **\$16 / 445 cases**

*Fermentation: Stainless steel*

*Time Aged: 6 months sur lees*

### 2008 RIGHT BANK PINOT NOIR

**90** “Deep red. Spicy red currant and strawberry on the nose, with sexy violet and mineral qualities adding complexity. Musky red fruit flavors are given spine by juicy acidity and fine-grained tannins, which add shape and grip to the back end. Gains sweetness with air, becoming broader and spicier on the long, sappy finish. I like this wine's structure and focus.” -Tanzer's International Wine Cellar (Jul/Aug 2011) **\$30 / 263 cases**

### 2008 LATITUDE 45 PINOT NOIR

**90** “Bright ruby. Pungent aromas of cherry and dark berry skin, with suave floral and spice notes adding complexity. Juicy, sharply focused black raspberry and bitter cherry flavors are firmed by dusty minerals and pick up smokiness with air. Shows good tannic grip on the finish but no hard edges, closing on notes of smoke and spice. This is balanced to age.” -Tanzer's International Wine Cellar (Jul/Aug 2011) **\$30 / 504 cases**
